PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

4,190 square foot+/- building located on the corner of North State Street and Main in Phillipsburg, OH. Previously a Chase Bank, the building is situated on 0.11 acres with an asphalt parking lot containing 5 regular spaces. The property is located on North State Street (Ohio Highway 49) in Phillipsburg Ohio, with a traffic count of 15,000 +/- vehicles daily. The interior of the building comprises of a main work area, a reception area, offices, an employee breakroom, and a restroom. Although the building formerly acted as a Chase Bank, it has many potential office, professional, or retail uses.

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Phillipsburg Montgomery County

Montgomery County is a county located in Ohio. As of the 2010 census, the population was 535,153, making it the fifth-most populous county in Ohio. The county seat is Dayton. The county was named in honor of Richard Montgomery, an American Revolutionary War general killed in 1775 while attempting to capture Quebec City, Canada.

Home to some of the greatest innovators past and present, Montgomery County is located in the heart of the Midwest. Situated at

the intersection of I-70 and I-75, Montgomery County provides access to one of the most highly traveled intersections in the United States.

Montgomery County is only 600 miles of:

- 61% of the U.S. population
- 63% of U.S. manufacturers
- 70% of all North American manufacturers
- and 80% of U.S. corporate Headquarters

Phillipsburg is a village in Montgomery County, Ohio, United States. The population was 557 at the 2010 census. It is part of the

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OHIO



Ohio is a Midwestern state in the Great Lakes region of the United States. Ohio is the 34th largest by area, the 7th most populous, and the 10th most densely populated of the 50 United States. The state's capital and largest city is Columbus. The state takes its name from the Ohio River. The name originated from the Iroquois word ohi-yo', meaning "great river" or "large creek". Partitioned from the Northwest Territory, the state was admitted to the Union as the 17th state (and the first under the Northwest Ordinance) on March 1, 1803. Ohio is historically known as the "Buckeye State" after its Ohio buckeye trees, and Ohioans are also known as "Buckeyes".



The government of Ohio is composed of the executive branch, led by the Governor; the legislative branch, which comprises the Ohio General Assembly; and the judicial branch, which is led by the state Supreme Court. Ohio occupies 16 seats in the United States House of Representatives. Ohio is known for its status as both a swing state and a bellwether in national elections. Six Presidents of the United States have been elected who had Ohio as their home state.



Ohio's geographic location has proven to be an asset for economic growth and expansion. Because Ohio links the Northeast to the Midwest, much cargo and business traffic passes through its borders along its well-developed highways. Ohio has the nation's 10th largest highway network, and is within a one-day drive of 50% of North America's population and 70% of North America's manufacturing capacity.

In 2010, Ohio was ranked No. 2 in the country for best business climate by Site Selection magazine, based on a business-activity database. The state has also won three consecutive Governor's Cup awards from the magazine, based on business growth and developments. As of 2010, Ohio's gross domestic product (GDP) was \$478 billion. This ranks Ohio's economy as the seventh-largest of all fifty states and the District of Columbia.

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


TRAFFIC COUNT


Currently, 70.0% of the 20,593 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 23.8%, renter occupied; and 6.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 20,462 housing units in the area - 72.8% owner occupied, 21.2% renter occupied, and 5.9% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.28%. Median home value in the area is \$130,749, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.18% annually to \$160,483.
